1. a/an + Noun

- A noun is a word that names a person, animal, place or thing.

- The words **a** and **an** usually come before singular nouns.

a is placed before consonant sounds, and **an** before vowel sounds.

a	a cat	a girl	a hat	a pen	a school
an	an apple	an egg	an igloo	an octopus	an umbrella

- There are 21 consonants and 5 vowels in the English alphabet.
