popular music of **Jamaican origin** that **combines native styles** with elements of rock and soul music. A famous singer of this style was **Bob Marley**.

a form of popular music that **evolved** in the 1950s from rhythm and blues, **characterized by the use** of **electric guitars**.

music which is **made with electronic equipment** such as synthesizers or **computers.**

popular music of **Puerto Rican origin** that **combines** rap with Caribbean rhythms.

a sub-genre of hip hop music that originated in the Southern United States during the late 1990s. The genre gets its name from an Atlanta slang word which refers to a place in which drugs are sold illegally.
