

REGGAE	A new popular music style <b>popular</b> among <b>young people</b> . They have a good <b>rhythm</b> , a <b>catchy melody</b> , and are easy to remember and sing.
ELECTRONIC MUSIC	A genre of <b>African-American music</b> of the 1980s and 1990s in which <b>rhyming lyrics</b> are “ <b>spoken</b> ” accompanied by music. It is <b>influenced by</b> <b>rap</b> and <b>funk</b> .
TRAP	popular music of <b>Jamaican origin</b> that <b>combines native styles</b> with elements of rock and soul music. A famous singer of this style was <b>Bob Marley</b> .
HIP-HOP	a form of popular music that <b>evolved</b> in the 1950s from rhythm and blues, <b>characterized by the use</b> of electric guitars.
REGGAETON	music which is <b>made with</b> <b>electronic equipment</b> such as synthesizers or <b>computers</b> .
ROCK AND ROLL	popular music of <b>Puerto Rican origin</b> that <b>combines</b> rap with Caribbean rhythms.
POP	a <b>sub-genre</b> of <b>hip hop</b> music that <b>originated</b> in the <b>Southern United States</b> during the late 1990s. The genre <b>gets its name</b> from an <b>Atlanta slang</b> word which <b>refers to</b> a place in which drugs are sold illegally.
