The state of Grenada is made up of three separate islands, they are Grenada, Carriacou and Pitite Martinique. Grenada being 120 square miles, Carriacou 13 square miles and Pitite Martinique 0.91 square mile.

The island of Grenada has 6 parishes and 5 towns: St. Patrick, St. Mark, St. John, St. George, St David and St. Andrew. The capital city is St. George's. St. Andrew is the biggest parish and St. Mark the smallest.
