Common, Proper and Abstract nouns

1. Proper

Proper noun refers to the name of a specific person, place & things.
examples: Miss Jane, Smith, Antarctica, Samsung,

2. Common

A name for an unspecified place, person, or thing
examples: Book, Car, Temple, Lamp, Subway, Teacher etc.

4. Abstract

An abstract noun expresses feelings, emotion, expression
examples: anger, happiness, truth etc.
