4. Physical examination	After the disease or illness has been diagnosed, the healthcare professional will write a treatment plan on this part of the report.
5. Test results and diagnosis	The reason why the patient is visiting the hospital or surgery should be recorded here. Any signs and symptoms of their illness should be written in this section.
6. Treatment plan and progress report	The patient's medical history should be included in the report. The questions in this section can include medical condition, medications and allergies.
