<b>Voiceless sounds take /s/</b> Imagine the sound a snake might make ...ssssssssss	<b>Voiced sounds take /z/</b> Imagine the sound a bee might make...zzzzzzzz	<b>These sounds take /iz/</b> Similar to the word 'is'
These sounds are voiceless: /f/ /h/ /k/ /p/ /t/	These sounds are voiced: /b/ /d/ /g/ /j/ /l/ /m/ /n/ /ng/ /r/ /v/ /w/ + all vowel sounds	/s/ /ks/ /z/ /dg/
<b>EXAMPLES:</b> laughs /laefs/ talks /toks/	<b>EXAMPLES:</b> rubs / rubz/ sings /singz/	<b>EXAMPLES:</b> kisses /kisiz/ boxes /boksiz/
