| 2. leader <input type="radio"/> | <input type="radio"/> To express your choice or opinion, especially by officially writing a mark on a paper or by raising your hand or speaking in a meeting |
| 3. democracy <input type="radio"/> | <input type="radio"/> A sovereign head of state, especially a king, queen or Emperor |
| 4. cabinet <input type="radio"/> | <input type="radio"/> One of the two groups of politicians who make laws in a political system. |
| 5. government <input type="radio"/> | <input type="radio"/> This is made up of M.P.s who are not part of the ruling Government |
| 6. parliament <input type="radio"/> | <input type="radio"/> These are special Members of Parliament who helps the Prime Minister to plan the affairs of the country. |
| 7. opposition <input type="radio"/> | <input type="radio"/> The most important law-making body in Jamaica. It is made up of the Senate and the House of Representatives |
