Simple Subjects and Predicates

A **complete subject** tells who or what the sentence is about. The **complete predicate** talks more about the subject. A **simple subject** is word or words that tells exactly who or what the sentence is about. The **simple predicate** is the word or words that show action or being in the sentence.

**Example:** Mary and Joan went to the grocery store.

**Complete subject** – Mary and Joan

**Simple subject** – Mary Joan

**Complete predicate** – went to the grocery store.

**Simple Predicate** – went
