Simple Subjects and Predicates

A **complete subject** tells who or what the sentence is about. The **complete predicate** talks more about the subject. A **simple subject** is word or words that tells exactly who or what the sentence is about. The **simple predicate** is the word or words that show action or being in the sentence.

Example: Mary and Joan went to the grocery store.

Complete subject – Mary and Joan

Simple subject – Mary Joan

Complete predicate- went to the grocery store.

Simple Predicate- went
