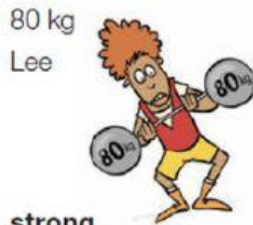


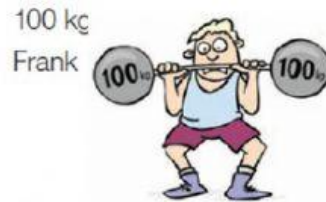

Jake is the **strongest** of the weight lifters.



expensive



more expensive



the most expensive

The necklace is the **most expensive** piece of jewelry.

Add *-est* to short adjectives to form the superlative: cheap + **est** = **cheapest**.

Add *most* before long adjectives: **most** + intelligent.

Note: Adjectives with irregular superlative forms: **good—best; bad—worst**.

B: They are up to 5.5 meters tall.

A: **How smart** are elephants?

B: They're among the smartest of animals.
