Part 3

Read the text below and answer questions 17 to 24.

FATHER OF INDEPENDENCE

Tunku Abdul Rahman Putra Al-Haj ibni Almarhum Sultan Abdul Hamid Halim Shah, born in Alor Setar on 8th February 1903 was the first Chief Minister of the Federation of Malaya from 1955 to 1957 before becoming Malaya's first Prime Minister after independence in 1957. He resigned in 1970. Tunku Abdul Rahman is widely regarded as the founding Father of Malaya and Father of Independence.

He was the son of Sultan Abdul Hamid Shah and Che Manjalara, the Sultan's fourth wife from Thailand. He studied in Alor Setar Malay Primary School before furthering his studies at the government English school, Sultan Abdul Hamid College. Later, he studied in Debsirin School in Bangkok and Penang Free School. When he was 17, he won the Kedah State Government scholarship to further his studies at Cambridge University but he did not do well. He graduated with a Bachelor Degree of Arts in Law and History. In 1939, he took the English bar exam which he had failed a few times and passed. In 1949, he was called to the bar and named as deputy public prosecutor in the Malayan Federal Legal Department. In 1951, he left the Legal Department to embark upon a political career.

He was married thrice. His first wife, Meriam Chong Abdullah with whom he had two children, died of Malaria. His second marriage to Violet Coulson ended in divorce. Tun Sharifah Rodziah bt Syed Alwi Barakbah was his third wife. She passed away in 2000 at the age of 80.

During the Japanese Occupation, Tunku remained as District Officer for one year and later as Superintendent of Education. In 1942, he helped feed escapees from The Death Railway. In 1951, Tunku became president of UMNO. He spearheaded the alliance of UMNO (United Malays National Organization), MCA (Malaysian Chinese Association) and MIC (Malayan Indian Congress). At midnight on 30th August, he stood at the flagpole in Merdeka Square in Kuala Lumpur when the Union Jack was lowered for the last time and the new Federation flag of Malaya was raised. The Alliance party won the general elections in 1959 and 1964. The formation of Malaysia in 1963 was one of his greatest achievements. He died peacefully on 6th December 1990 at the age of 87.
