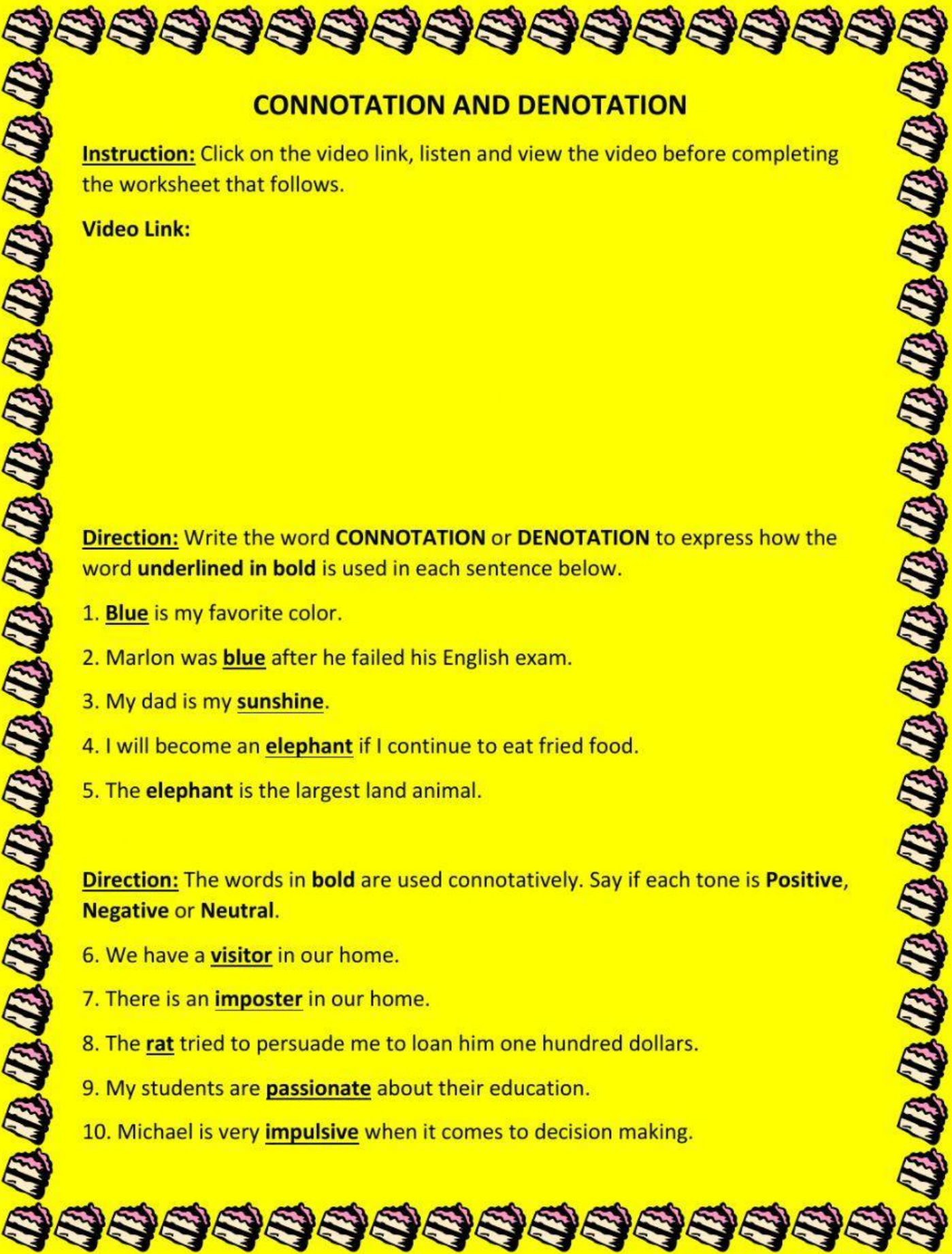




CONNOTATION AND DENOTATION
