The third person singular (**he, she, it**) is usually formed by adding **-S** to the root. Sometimes **-es** is added. **-S, -ES** and **IES** are added in positive sentences.

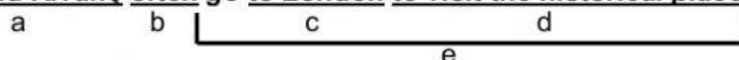

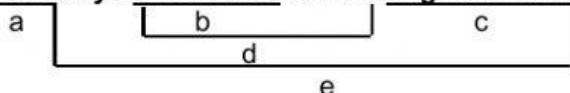
