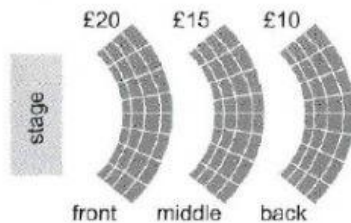




Comparative Adjectives

happy	the happiest

- irregular adjectives:

good	the best
bad	the worst
