

The Four Types of Writing

1. Narrative Writing – This type of writing tells a story. It is mainly written for entertainment. A personal narrative tells a story about the writer.




2. Descriptive Writing – This type of writing may describe a person, place, thing or an event. The senses as well as figurative language such as similes and metaphors are used to give details about what is being described so that a clear picture is painted in the reader's mind.



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3. Expository Writing—This type of writing provides information, gives an explanation or directions.
