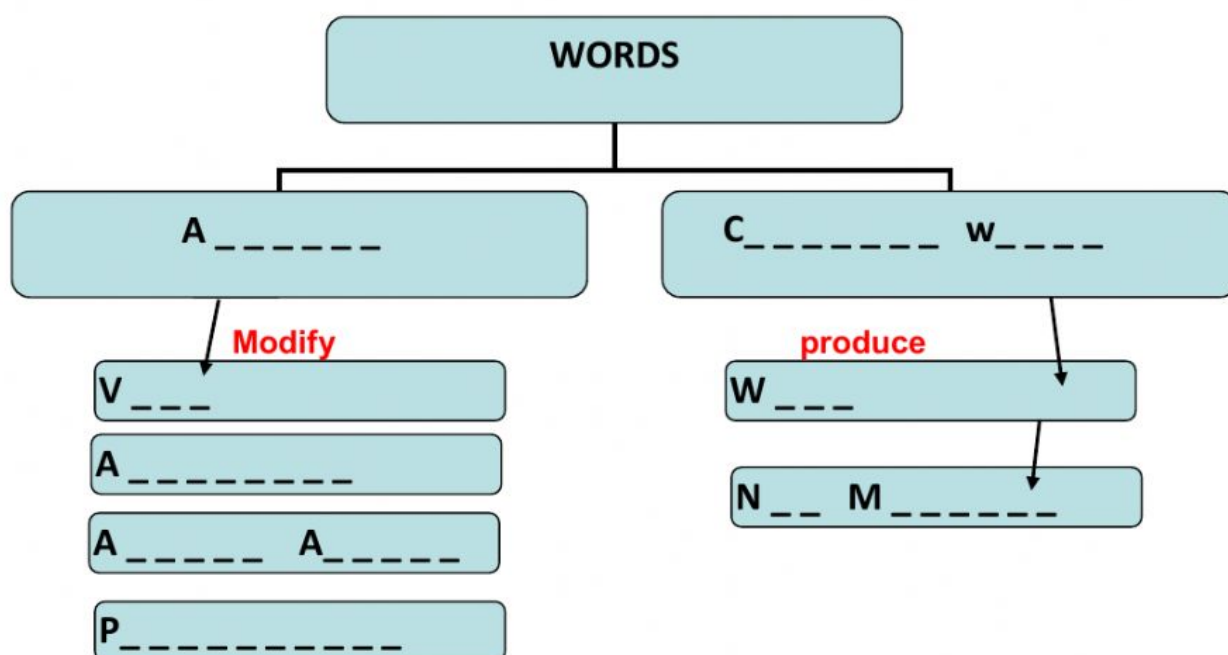

6. Complete the concept map according to the following information. Use the red words.


