Our Environment

Our **environment** is everything around us. We can divide it into **natural** and **built** (human-made) things. Human beings change the environment.

Natural things in the environment includes: **sun, sea/oceans, rivers, sky, cloud, soil, trees, grass, birds, butterfly** and other **animals**.

Built (human-made) things in the environment includes: **buildings, roads, vehicles (car, truck, van** etc.)

Our natural environment has different parts:

- **Non-living things**: air, water, sunlight, land.
- **Living things**: plants, animals and humans.

These all depend on each other. They are balanced. When humans change one part, this affects all the other parts.

We call the natural things that we use **natural resources**. There is a limit to the amounts of natural resources in our environment. If we use too much of a resource or damage it then it can run out.
