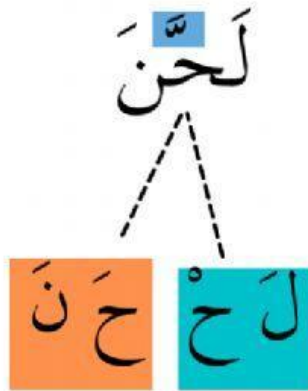


Lesson Four- Shadda

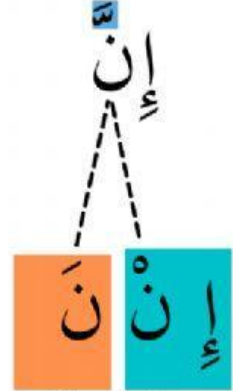
A shadda symbol means that there are two of the same letter, we can call them the **"twin letters"** or **"double letters"**. A sukun is always added to the first letter and the second letter follows the original harakat that is written with the shadda.
