

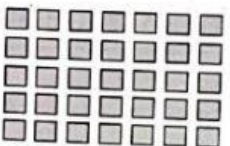

Challenge 1 Use these arrays to help you answer each division question.

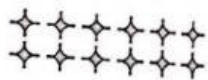
