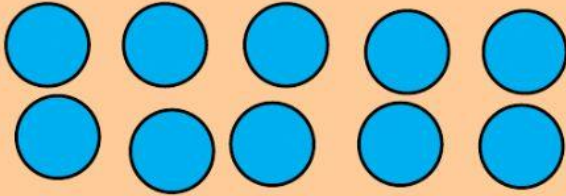


Addition Word Problems Practice

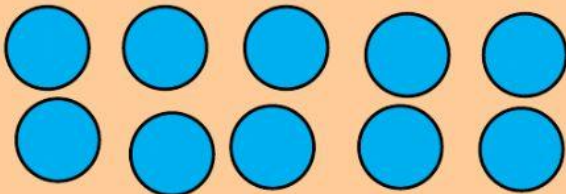
Instructions: Read the word problems and solve. Drag the circles to represent the numbers.

a. Sam has 5 toys. He got 2 more. How many toys does he have in all?



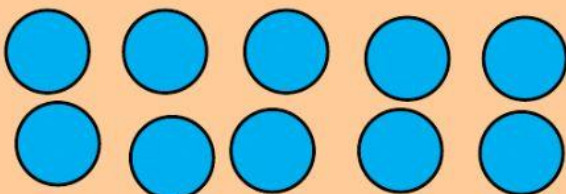

b. The girl has 4 dolls. Her mom gave her 2 more dolls. How many dolls does she have altogether?



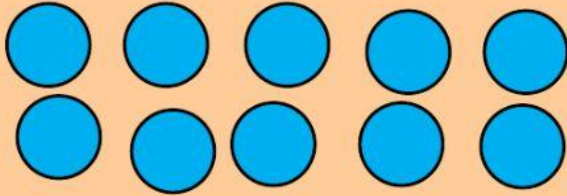

c. My teacher has 5 boys and 5 girls in her class. What is five plus five?



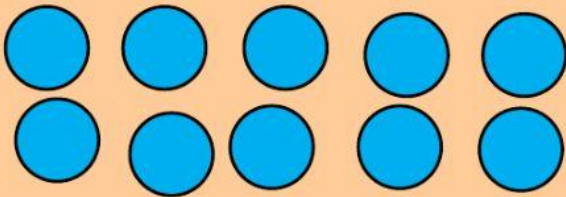
