Abu Huraira رضي الله عنه narrated:

He said, "To join others in worship alongside Allah, to practice sorcery, to take a life which Allah has forbidden except in a just cause, to consume Ribā (usury), to consume an orphan's property, to flee from the battlefield, and to wrongfully accuse chaste believing pious women (of committing adultery)..” [Al Bukhārī and Muslim]
