The Founding of the thirteen colonies

The U.S is fifty states strong today, but it began as thirteen small colonies. It all started with Virginia when wealthy London **1**_____ asked the British King to set up shop in what was known as the **2**_____. One hundred and four British colonists settled at Jamestown forming the first permanent **3**_____ colony. Next up, Massachusetts was founded after being established by the pilgrims who sailed the **4**_____ to Plymouth. Six years later New York was pioneered by the Dutch who called it New Amsterdam.

Maryland, which became home to Puritans, **5**_____ and Catholics, who didn't get along, was established in 1634. Maryland was followed by Connecticut when one hundred Puritans left Massachusetts to start a new colony at **6**_____ and Rhode Island, which was originally called Red Island by the Dutch. **7**_____, New Hampshire, which at various points were part of Maryland and Massachusetts came next. Virginian colonists established **8**_____ ten years before South Carolina was granted a charter

forming one Carolina colony until 1712. New Jersey was first settled in 1664 though the small future **9**_____ state was actually in two parts for nearly forty years.

Pennsylvania was granted to William Penn in 1681 in payment for a **10**_____ that the British King owed Penn's father. That leaves **11**_____, which was established as a penal colony for English debtors and a buffer zone between the British colonies and Florida, which was controlled by the **12**_____. Spain held on to Florida until 1821, a full **13**_____ years after the original thirteen colonies became the United States of America.
