Turn sbd away	• to refuse to deal or give service: <i>đuổi ai ra</i>
Turn sbd/sth down	• to reject an offer, a job, a romantic proposa, to lower the volume or intensity of a TV, radio, heater etc.: <i>từ chối</i>
Turn in = hand in	• to submit (a paper, homework, report etc.): <i>nộp bài</i>
Turn into	• <i>biến thành, trở thành</i>
Turn off	• <i>tắt đi</i>
Turn on	• <i>bật lên</i>
Turn out	• to switch off a light: <i>tắt đèn</i> • to be discovered to be; to prove to be: <i>hóa ra là...</i>
Turn over	• to change position so that the other side is facing towards the outside or the top: <i>lật</i>
Turn round	• to change position or direction so as to face the other way; to make somebody/something do this: <i>quay lại</i>
Turn up	• to increase the volume or intensity of a TV, radio, heater etc.: <i>tăng âm lượng</i> • to appear unexpectedly, arrive: <i>xuất hiện (một cách tình cờ), đến</i>

Look back: Hồi tưởng lại quá khứ
Look down on: Coi thường ai
Look for: Tìm kiếm (thứ bị mất hoặc thứ bạn đang cần)
Look forward to: mong chờ, hứng thú về một điều gì đó trong tương lai
Look in on: Nhân tiện ghé thăm ai
Look into: Điều tra, kiểm tra
Look on: Xem (một hoạt động/sự kiện nhưng không tham gia)
Look out: “Cẩn thận”, “Coi chừng”
Look out for (something or someone): Đề ý, đợi chờ (một cái gì sẽ xảy đến)
Look out for someone: Coi sóc, bảo vệ ai
Look over: Soát lại
Look to: Trông cậy, tin vào ai
Look through: Đọc lướt qua, soát lại
Look something up: Tìm kiếm thông tin
Look someone up: Thăm ai (bạn cũ)
