

Unit 5 Addition and subtraction: revision

Mental addition

Use different methods to add numbers mentally.

Use patterns:

$$6 + 7 = 13$$

$$86 + 7 = 93$$

$$60 + 70 = 130$$

Use rounding:

$$37 + 9 \rightarrow 37 + 10 - 1 = 46$$

$$23 + 19 \rightarrow 23 + 20 - 1 = 42$$

Use near doubles:

$$18 + 19 = 18 + 18 + 1 = 37$$

$$25 + 26 = 25 + 25 + 1 = 51$$

If you need to add 2-digit numbers in your head, it helps to break the numbers up and add the tens then the ones.

Example

$$85 + 57$$

Use these three steps:

1 Hold the bigger number in your head: 85

2 Break 57 into 50 + 7. Add the tens: $85 + 50 = 135$

3 Add the ones: $135 + 7 = 142$

Mental subtraction

When you subtract numbers in your head, look at the numbers to help you choose the best method to find the answer. Here are some possible methods, but choose the one that works for you.

Use patterns:

$$\begin{aligned} 13 - 8 &= 5 \\ 53 - 8 &= 45 \\ 130 - 80 &= 50 \end{aligned}$$

Use rounding:

$$\begin{aligned} 24 - 9 &\rightarrow 24 - 10 + 1 = 15 \\ 35 - 19 &\rightarrow 35 - 20 + 1 = 16 \end{aligned}$$

Use inverses:

$$\begin{aligned} 25 - \underline{\quad} &= 18 \\ 18 + \underline{\quad} &= 25 \\ 18 + 7 &= 25 \\ 25 - 7 &= 18 \end{aligned}$$

A good method for subtracting mentally is to find the difference between the numbers by counting on.

Example

What is the difference between 38 and 64?



This number line shows exactly what goes on in your head. Count on from 38 to 40. Hold the 2 in your head. 40 to 64 is 24. $24 + 2$ is 26. So $64 - 38 = 26$
