Types of Sentences

There are **four** types of sentences: declarative, interrogative, imperative, and exclamatory.

Declarative sentences make a statement and ends in a full stop (.).

Example: I walked for 3 miles this morning.

Interrogative sentences ask a question and end in a question mark (?).

Example: What school do you attend?

Imperative sentences make a command or gives a request and ends in a full stop (.).

Example: Kenneth, make up your bed.

Exclamatory sentences make a statement with expression and ends with an exclamation mark (!).

Example: Wow, that is a very tall waterslide!
