3) Jane took 356 minutes to complete homework in English and Mathematics. She took 204 minutes to complete English. How much time she took to complete Mathematics?

4) There are 4500 books in a library. They are either written in English or Arabic. If 2894 books are in English Language, then how many books are in Arabic language?



5) There are 1348 girls in a school. If the total number of students in the school is 2900, then what is the number of boys in the school?

6) Dave earns \$1485 a month and his wife earns \$1760. If Dave gets a pay rise of \$217 a month, how much less than his wife does he earn?



7) Derek needs to cover a distance of 1456 km to reach his house and if he covers 1152 km by train and rest by bus. How much distance does he cover by bus?

8) A study of 9000 people found that 6897 were right-handed, 1746 were left-handed and the rest were ambidextrous (could use either hand). How many were ambidextrous?
