I also have two sisters, Lisa and Maggie.

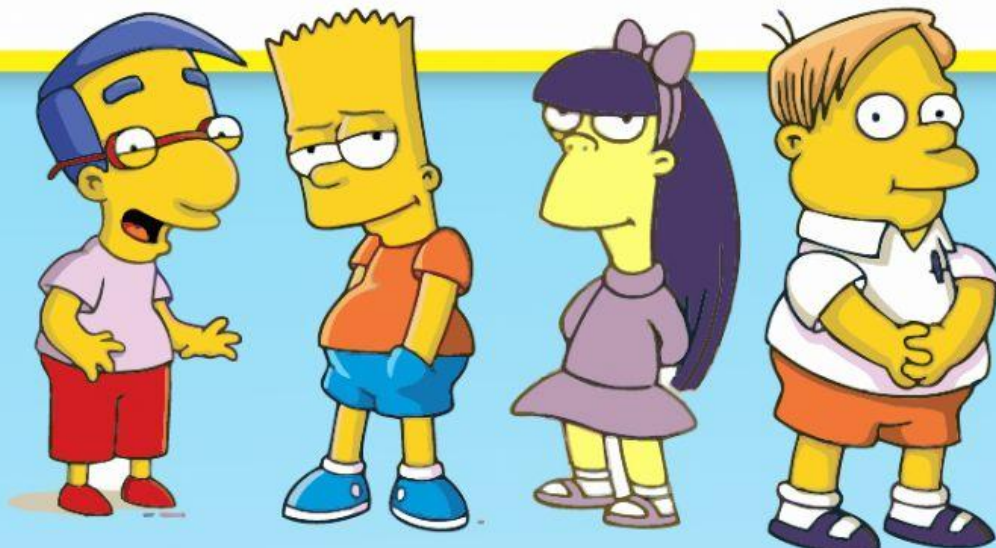
Every day I get up early, have breakfast
