

Part 2: **Used to** – **Be / get used to**

USED TO

1. Form:

(+) S + **used to** + **Verb**

(-) S + **didn't** + **use to** + **Verb**

(?) **Did** + S + **use to** + **Verb?**

2. Usage:

- We use this expression to talk about **habits or repeated actions in the past** which we don't do in the present. We also use it to talk about **states in the past which are no longer true**. => **Việc đã từng làm trong quá khứ, nay không làm nữa.**

Ex: I **used to** have long hair (but now I have short hair).

They **used to** live in India (but now they live in Germany).

Did you **use to** be a teacher? Yes, I did.

I **didn't use to** want to have a nice house.

BE / GET USED TO

1. Form:

(+) S + **to be/ get + used to** + **V-ing**.

(-) S + **not + to be / get + used to** + **V-ing**.

(?) **To be** + S + **used to** + **V-ing?**

Do/ Does / Did... + S + **get + used to** + **V-ing?**

2. Usage:

BE USED TO	GET USED TO
- If you are used to something, you are accustomed to it – you don't find it unusual. ⇒ Đã quen làm gì... - Be used to talks about the result (kết quả) Ex: I found Slovak food very strange at first but I'm used to it now.	- If you get used to something or you are getting used to something you are becoming accustomed to it. ⇒ Đang dần làm quen với... - Get used to talks about the process. (quá trình) Ex: I'm getting used to driving on the right.

- Both 'be used to' and 'get used to' are followed by **a noun** (or pronoun) or the gerund – the **'ing'** form of a verb.

Ex: I can't **get used to getting** up so early. I'm tired all the time.

He's **not used to** the weather here yet. He's finding it very cold.

- 'Be/get used to' can be used with **past, present and future** tenses.

Ex: You might find it strange at first but you'll soon **get used to** it.

He **wasn't used to** the heat and he caught sunstroke.
