We use them when there are two sentences which are related.
For example:



ALTHOUGH + SUBJECT/VERB

ALTHOUGH HE STUDIED, HE FAILED THE TEST.

DESPITE + NOUN/GERUND

DESPITE STUDYING, HE FAILED THE TEST.

HE STUDIED. HOWEVER, HE FAILED THE TEST.

ALTHOUGH

Although is used for introducing a statement that makes the main statement in a sentence seem.

Examples

- **Although** it rained all day, we enjoyed the party very much.
- He failed in the exam, **although** he studied very hard.
- They didn't go to the party, **although** they were invited.

DESPITE

Despite is a preposition.
After despite we use:
Despite + noun/pronoun.
Despite + verb- ing

Examples

- **Despite** the wind, we went fishing.
- **Despite** her tiredness, Elisa tries to help us.
- **Despite** missing the bus, he arrived on time
- **Despite** being a millionaire, she lives in a very small flat.

HOWEVER

We can express a contrast by using the adverb **however** with two sentences. It is always followed by a comma.

Examples

- He was feeling very ill. **However**, he went to school.
- Some people disagree with this idea, **however**, it's never been proven right.
- She is the best student in school. **However**, she doesn't do homeworks on time.
