1. Affirmative:

Form:	S + was/were + V-ing.
Notes:	I/ He/ She/ It/ Danh từ số ít – was S= We/ You/ They/ Danh từ số nhiều – were
Example:	- We were just talking about it before you arrived. (

2. Negative:

Form:	S + was/were + not + V-ing
	was not = wasn't / were not = weren't
Example:	- He wasn't working when his boss came yesterday.

3. Question:

Form:	Q: Was / Were + S + V-ing? A: Yes, S + was/were. No, S + wasn't/weren't.
Example:	Q: Was your mother going to the market at 7 A.M yesterday? A: Yes, she was/ No, she wasn't
