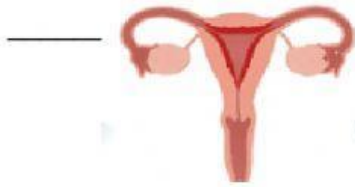


Menstrual Cycle

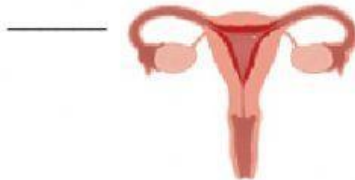
Arrange the menstrual cycle in order. Write 1-4.



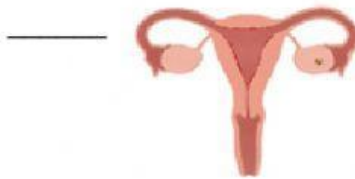
The uterus prepares for a possible fertilization and implantation by making the uterine lining grow and thicken.



The blood comes out of the vagina, the uterine lining breaks down.



Ovulation takes place, the egg is released from the ovary and travels along the oviduct and waits for a sperm cell.



Days 6-13 is a repair period for the uterine lining and development period for an egg to mature.
