

**TOPIC: THINGS THAT USE BATTERIES****Instructions to parents/guardians:**Step 1:

1. Collect as many things that use dry cells or batteries to work or function.
2. Put around the room where you are teaching your child.
3. Take any remote controller with you.
4. Ask your child how does the remote control work or function.
5. If they know how it works, please proceed to Step 2. But if they don't, please explain to them that the remote control works by using batteries.

Step 2:

1. Instruct them to **find 3 the things that uses dry cells or batteries (the ones you put around the room)**.
2. Help them to list out the names of the objects that they have found.

Step 3:

1. Explain to them that **many things use dry cells or batteries** nowadays.
2. Explain to them that it is because it's convenient and easier to bring them everywhere, e.g. hand phone, torch light and etc.
3. Also explain to them some things also come in different version, one works using the mains electricity and ones works with batteries only, e.g. vacuum cleaner and a portable vacuum.

Step 4:

1. Take out some batteries.
2. Explain to them that **batteries are also called dry cells**.
3. Also explain to them that batteries also have different types.
4. Please google different types of batteries and discuss.
5. Tell them cars also use a special kind of dry cells/batteries to work (google up car batteries).
6. Ask them to find the rest of the objects that uses batteries to work around the room.

Select the objects that use dry cells or batteries to work.
