



# 8 tips to stay safe online

1 Be nice to people online.




2 Take care with what you share.



3 Keep personal information private.




4 Check your privacy settings.

1) Post any personal information online – like your address, email address or mobile number.

2) Think carefully before posting pictures or videos of yourself. Once you've put a picture of yourself online most people can see it and may be able to download it, it's not just yours anymore.

3) Keep your privacy settings as high as possible

4) Remember that not everyone online is who they say they are

5) Be friendly with people you don't know

6) Meet up with people you've met online. Don't peak to your parent or carer about people suggesting you to do so.

7) Give out your passwords

8) Think carefully about what you say before you post something online

9) Respect other people's views, even if you don't agree with someone else's views doesn't mean you need to be rude

10) If you see something online that makes you feel uncomfortable, unsafe or worried: keep the silence, don't tell anybody, stay in the website, don't turn off your computer.
