4. There are 136 students in the fourth grade at Claymont Elementary School. 27 of them brought sack lunches to school. The rest buy the hot lunch. How many students are buying a hot lunch?

5. Erasers come in boxes of 10. Bishop has 14 boxes. James has 5 boxes.
