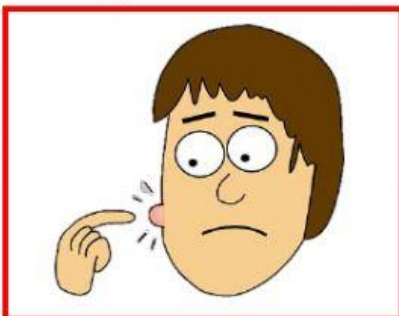
We use **SHOULD OR SHOULDN'T** to give advice. Examples:

NEW CORONAVIRUS

Covid-19 or 2019-nCov

WHAT IS IT? Q

COVID-19 is the infectious disease caused by the most recently discovered coronavirus. This new virus and disease were unknown before the outbreak began in Wuhan, China, in December 2019. COVID-19 is now a pandemic affecting many countries globally.

PREVENTION

Stay at home when you are sick	Don't eat raw food, thoroughly cook meat & egg.
Avoid close contact with people who are sick.	Avoid touching eyes, nose, & mouth with unwashed hands.
Wash your hands at least 20 seconds.	Clean & disinfect frequently touched object & surfaces.
Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue.	Avoid crowded places

SYMPTOMS

Common Less typical

Hemoptysis
 Dry Cough
 Phlegm Buildup
 Shortness of breath
 Fever
 Headache
 Fatigue
 Diarrhea
 Aching muscles

INCUBATION

If you have minor symptoms, such as a slight cough or a mild fever, there is generally no need to seek medical care. Stay at home, self-isolate and monitor your symptoms. Follow national guidance on self-isolation.
