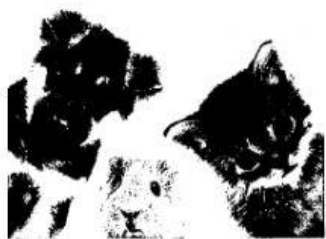
Read the passage.
