Relative pronoun **who** is used only for people.

Relative pronoun, **which** is used for animals or things.

Relative pronoun, **whose** is used for people to show possession.

These are some more examples:

The **man** who brought the parcel has left.

My cat caught the **rat** which ate the cheese.

That is the woman whose **shoes** was stolen.

Where is the **boy** who spoke to me just now?

The **oranges** which I bought yesterday are sour.

That child whose **parents** are not here is crying.
