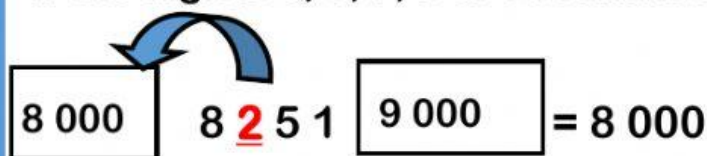


How to round numbers to the thousands place.

- First, find the two thousands the number is between
- Hint (the digit in the thousands place gives the first thousand)
- Example: 5 786
- 5 is in the thousands place, so 5000 is the first number
- add 1000 to the number to get the second number
(5000 + 1000 = 6000)
- So, 5 786 is between 5 000 and 6 000.
- Next, count 3 digits from the end of the number to used to tell if to round the number up or down. 5 7 8 6 – 7 is the third digit from the end
- If the digit is 0, 1, 2, 3 or 4 round it down
- If the digit is 5, 6, 7, 8 or 9 round it up



$\boxed{8\ 000}$ 8 2 5 1 $\boxed{9\ 000}$ = 8 000
