REMEMBER: When you read a story or an article, understanding the events as they occur is simplified when we engage the order of events, also known as chronological order. In some writing, the events follow a normal time order by one event following the other. Sometimes authors refer to events that occur in the past, or that are happening now, or that will happen in the future. Look for clue words such as these to determine the order of events: ***first, next, then, after, finally, meanwhile, yesterday, today, and afterward*** (these are not limited).
