

# Singular or Plural? (PART 1)

There are countable and uncountable nouns.

Only **countable nouns** have **singular** and **plural** forms.



Add 's' to most nouns:

cat -> cats



Add 'es' to nouns that end with -s, -sh, -ch, -x or -z:

box -> boxes



For nouns ending with a 'y' with a consonant before the 'y', change the 'y' to 'ies':

strawberry -> strawberries



For nouns ending with a 'y' with a vowel before the 'y', simply add 's':

key -> keys
