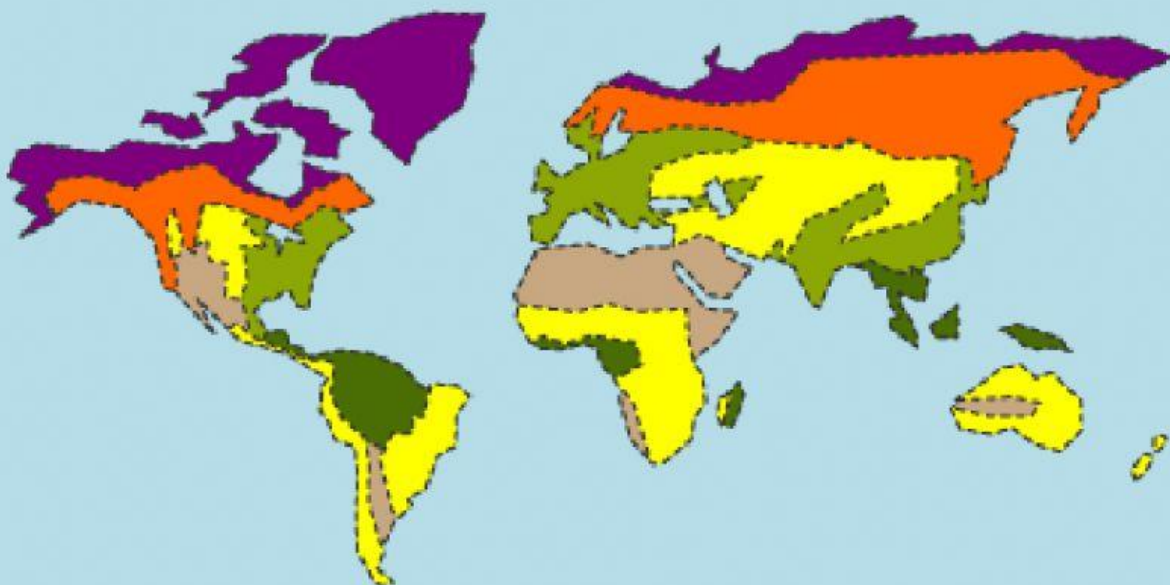
A _____ is a large region of Earth that has a certain climate and certain types of living things.

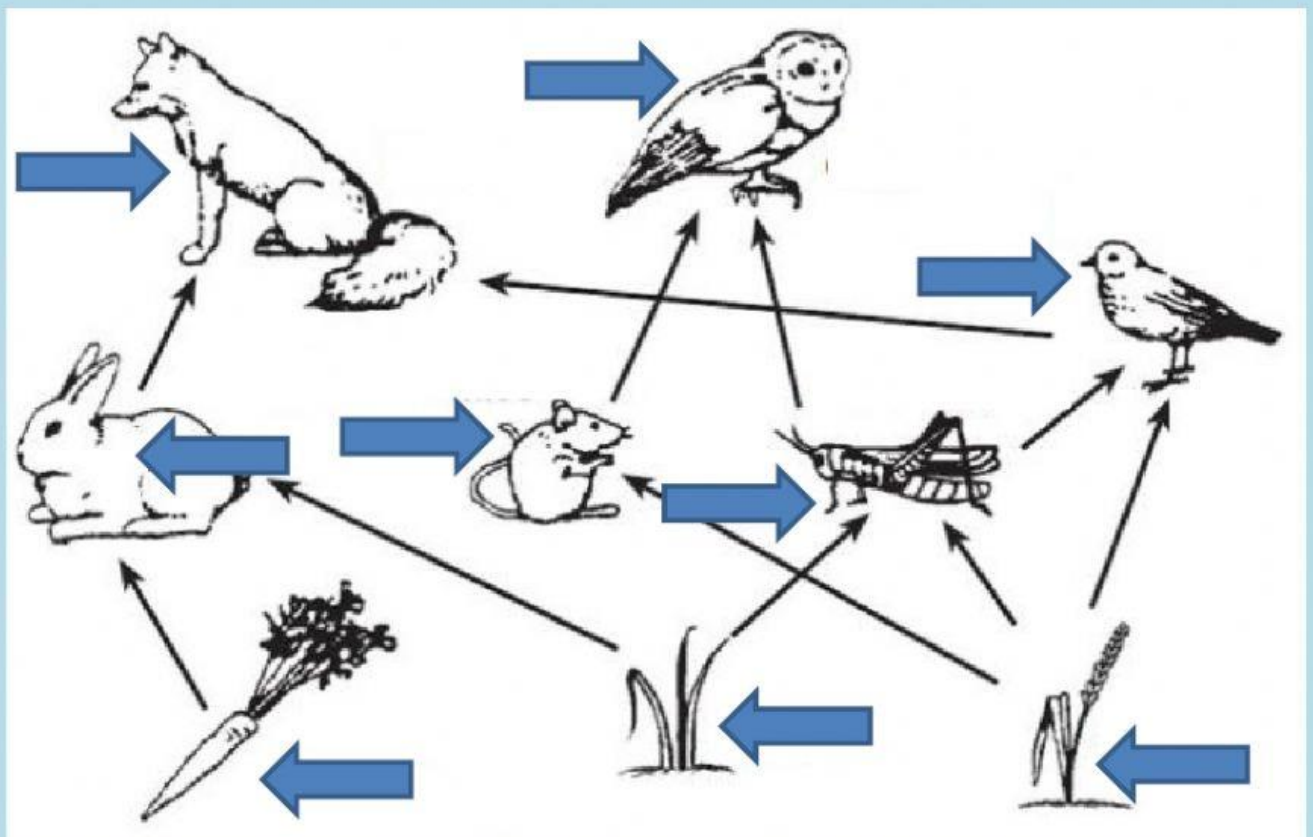


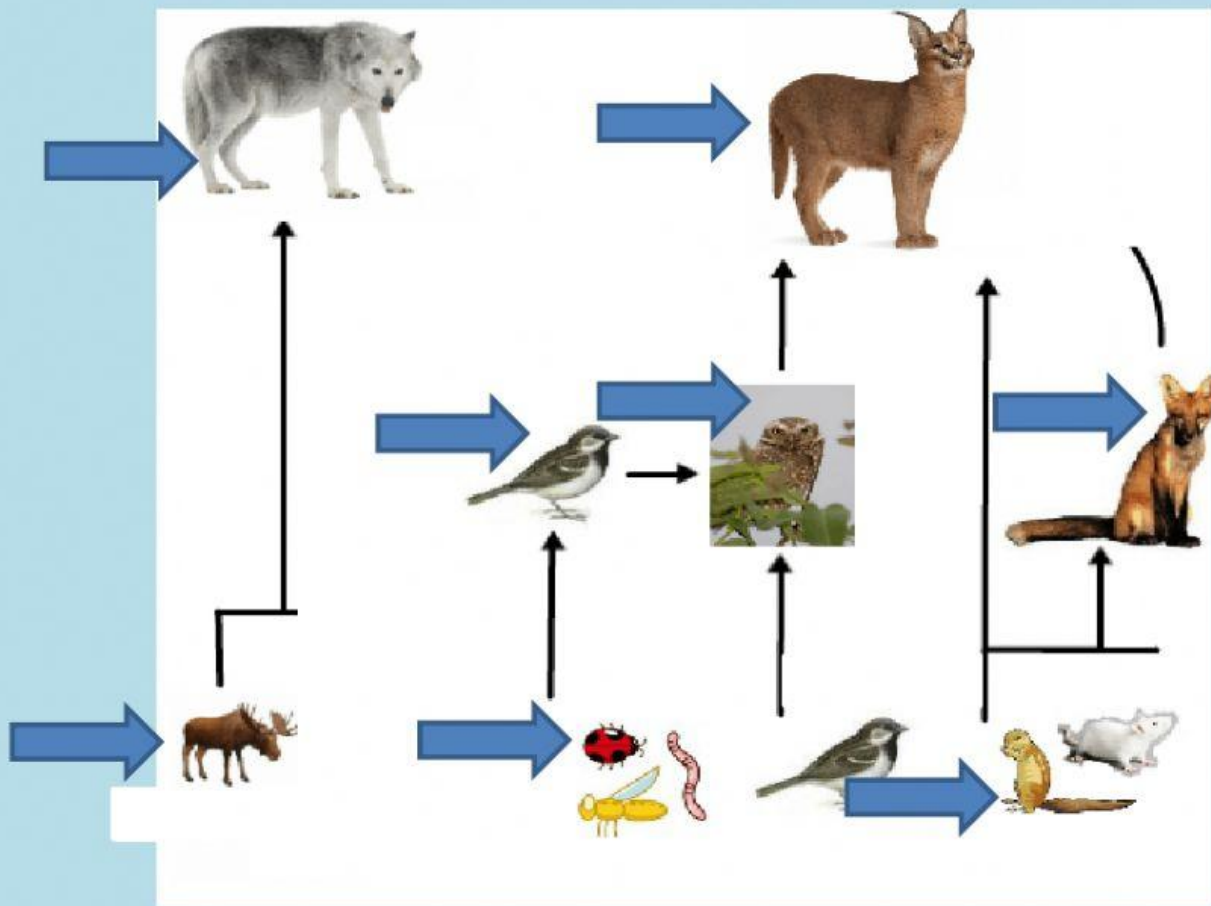
Population a group of individuals from the same species living in the same area and interacting with each other (for example a group of eels)

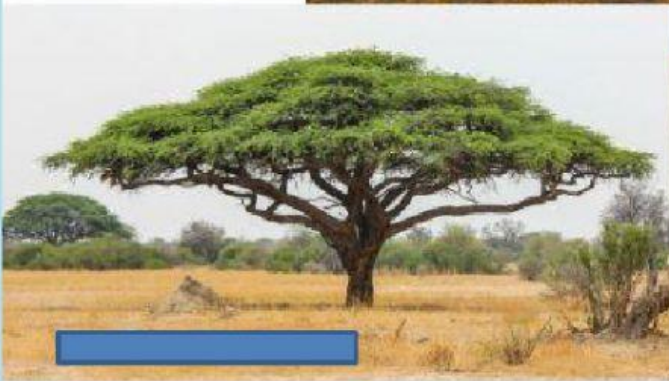

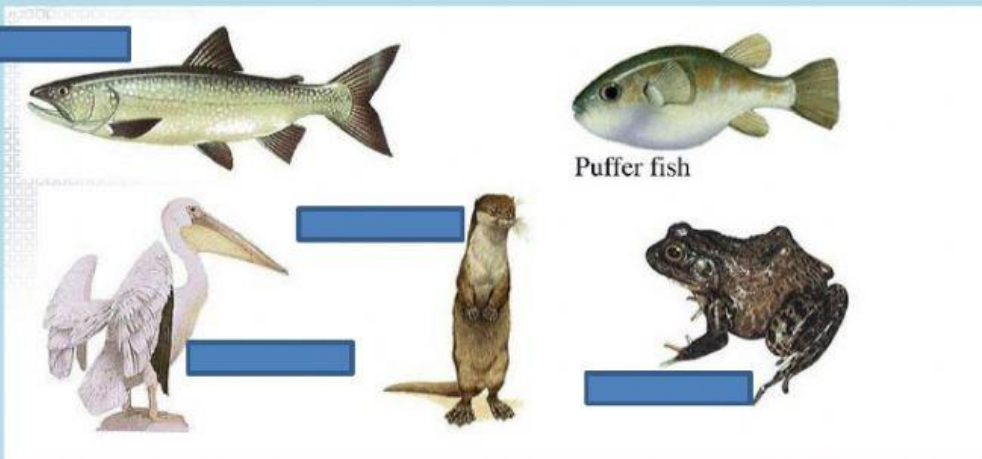
