### Writing a Story Beginning

#### How to Write a Story Beginning

1. Tell **who** is in the story.
2. Tell **what** is happening.
3. Tell **when** the story takes place.
4. Tell **where** the story happens.

The 4 W's

#### STEP 1...Prewriting.../Brainstorming

#### BEGINNING:

**Who:** Mrs Strachan, Tantalaya, **Isaiah**, Vanae

**What:** having fun at beach

**When:** on Sunday afternoon

**Where:** at Goodman's Bay

**Problem:** Isaiah can't swim;

#### MIDDLE: the action. Tell what happened

First...

Next...

After that...

Then...

#### ENDING: How does it end?

- happy or sad ending
- how was the problem solved?
- Is there a lesson you learned?
