













Angle of elevation

The **angle of elevation** is formed between the **horizontal / declined** line of sight and the **inclined / declined** line of sight.

Angle of depression

The **angle of depression** is formed between the **horizontal / inclined** line of sight and the **inclined / declined** line of sight.

*What can we infer about the **angles of elevation and depression** from the scenario depicted in number (8)?*

angle of elevation < angle of depression or **angle of elevation = angle of depression**
