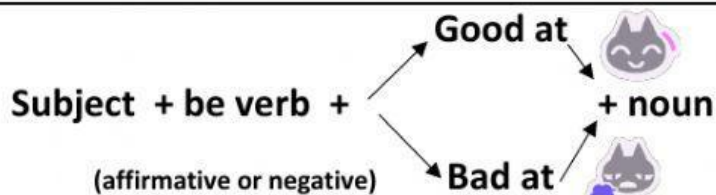


Unit 1: Good and Bad at

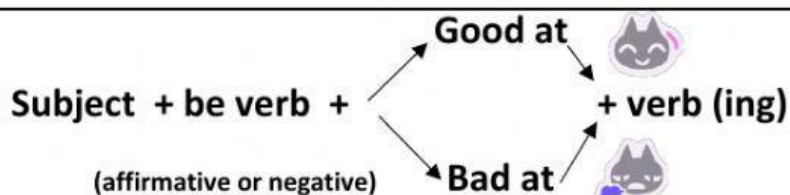


Examples:
