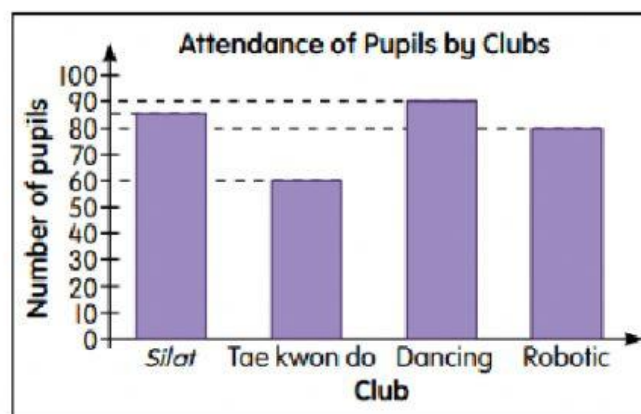

QUESTION 1



The bar graph shows the attendance of pupils by clubs.

a) What is the total number of pupils in the four clubs?

- Step 1:

| C | $75 + 70 + 90 + 80$ |
| D | $75 + 70 + 100 + 90$ |

b) The four clubs have a total number of 350 members. How many members are absent?

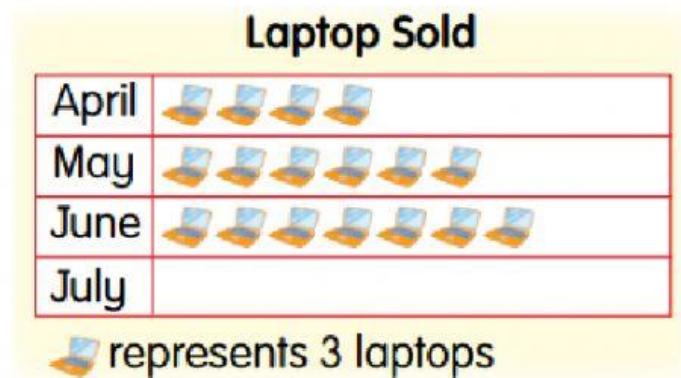

The pictograph shows the number of laptops sold in three months.
The sales in July is not shown



The total number of laptops sold in 4 months is 60.

a) How many laptops were sold in July?

Total number of laptops sold in April, May and June

- A $12 + 18 + 21$
- B $12 + 15 + 20$
- C $4 + 6 + 7$
- D $4 + 5 + 6$

Number of laptops sold in July

- A $60 - 51$
- B $60 - 15$
- C $60 - 17$
- D $60 + 5$
