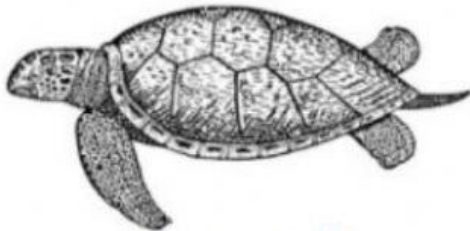
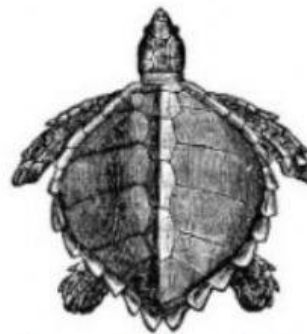


Two Types of Sea Turtles
