It is essential because it will make the reader decide whether he wants to read the whole paper or not.

It should not be longer than 200 words.

Tips:

1. Clearly describe the **purpose**
research methods
objectives

Be concise and use only relevant information

2. Try to answer some of these questions:

Why are you conducting this research?

How will the study contribute to the field?

What is the main problem your research is trying to solve?

3. Do not use 1st person:

~~What I analyzed ...~~

~~I wanted to learn about ...~~

~~The results that I found ...~~

4. Use expressions such as:

This research paper analyzes...

This project also evaluates...

One of the main aspects investigated is ...

The aim of this research is/was...

The research provides answers to ...

The main aims of this project are to...

This project provides answers to questions like these, and explains what cooperatives are like, from their values to how they work.
