Reading skills

In order to do this type of reading task, you need the skills of reading for specific information.

Steps to do the matching information exercises

• **This is a suggested strategy to do the matching information exercise.**

- + **Step 1:** Read the instructions carefully
- + **Step 2:** Read the questions first and underline the key words.
- + **Step 3:** Quickly skim the reading text to get the general meaning of each paragraph
- + **Step 4:** Read the question statements again and scan the reading text to find the answer.

Scanning the text means you need to look for some specific words in the text that are mostly **synonyms** or **paraphrases**, not the same as some keywords from the questions.

- + **Step 5:** Mark the answer if it matches to the paragraph. If not, move to other paragraphs.

• **Useful tips you should remember while doing this type of reading task:**

- + Focus on looking for one piece of information instead of understanding the whole text.
- + Do the easiest questions first. They contain the names, places, numbers or some unusual words so it's easy to find them in the text, too.
- + The same paragraph might contain more than one answer.
