PRESENT SIMPLE – NEGATIVE SENTENCES

A. Read and analyze the information about Present Simple in negative form.

Don't - Doesn't

We use **Don't** or **Doesn't** to make a **negative sentence** in the simple present tense.*

* Exceptions: Negative sentences that use *To Be* or *Modal Verbs* (can, might, etc.)

Subject <u>I / you / we / they</u> <u>he / she / it</u>	Auxiliary <u>don't</u> <u>doesn't</u>	Verb ** <u>go</u> ... <u>want</u> ... <u>like</u> ...
--	--	---

Affirmative: You speak English.
 Negative: You **don't** speak English.

Affirmative: He speaks English.
 Negative: He **doesn't** speak English.

Be careful... I **no** live in Japan. **X**
 I **don't** live in Japan. **✓**

Affirmative: She has a cat. **✓**
 Negative: She **doesn't** **has** a cat. **X**
 Negative: She **doesn't** **have** a cat. **✓**

** The base form of the infinitive = **to go**, **to need**, **to speak**, **to live**
 Third person verbs lose the final "s" in negative sentences.

Contractions
don't = do not
doesn't = does not








